Restore is an off-site educational provision managed by Carr Manor Community School supporting a number of secondary schools within the Leeds area. Restore is based within ARK, a community and youth space setup by the charity CATCH. Restore is staffed with specialist learning mentors and works with a range of external partner organisations to maximise the learning and development of young people.





Restore is a facility focused on respite and reintegration. During a pupil's placement at Restore their educational, behavioural and social needs can be addressed with a view to them returning promptly, as appropriate, to mainstream education.

Restore aims to provide a safe and enriching environment for children to learn and develop academically, socially and emotionally, whilst cultivating a sense

> of empathy and understanding of the world in which they exist and how their actions impact both themselves and those around them.

Through a holistic, restorative, pupil centred approach, Restore aims to develop young people, so that they visit only once and return to mainstream education with an

increased willingness to be there and to learn. Inclusive practice is at the centre of all the work carried out with pupils.

Working with CATCH we hope to engage pupils in extracurricular youth activities which will provide them with social and life skills.





WOUR ETHOS

At Restore we:

- Strive to maintain a safe and structured learning environment.
- Help pupils fulfil their academic potential by engaging them in their learning.
- Ensure we challenge and engage each pupil by developing their character for learning and desire to succeed academically.
- Use alternative approaches to teaching and learning in order to maximise engagement.
- Listen to the pupil and respond with flexibility, ensuring those with specific needs can work at an appropriate pace and maximise their potential.
- Place significant focus on activities beyond each pupil's school curriculum, in order to holistically enhance each pupil's development.
- Encourage pupils to ask questions and develop communications skills.
- Help pupils to understand and adopt a healthy, physically active and environmentally friendly lifestyle.

We work towards pupils being able to:

- Recognise and understand how to keep themselves safe.
- Show confidence in their interactions with other people.
- Make positive contributions in school and the wider community.
- Show commitment and confidence to re-engage in their school curriculum.
- Have a strong sense of responsibility, selfregulation and coping strategies.
